Presenter: Kristina Ferrare, Onondaga County Cornell Cooperative Extension

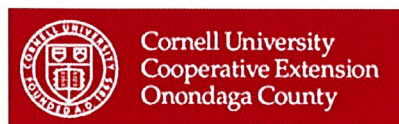
The workshop will cover tick identification, tick habitat, taking preventative measures through dress, appropriate use of pesticides, habitat management, and using concepts of Integrated Pest Management to reduce the risk of tick bites. I will have examples of a tick flag for tick drags, tick tubes and a permethrin spray. Each household in attendance will receive one tick kit which contains a microtweezers for removing ticks according to CDC guidelines.
