1. The meeting was called to order at 5:01 p.m.

2. **Minutes**

A motion was made by Member McGrew and seconded by Member Champagne to approve the minutes of October 28, 2020. The motion passed unanimously.

Member Denton reviewed the Draft Public Safety Advisory Committee Plan that was drafted in response to the Governor's Executive Order # 203.

The committee discussed revisiting the consolidation agreement for the Police Department.

5. **Chiefs Report**

- Chief Crowell reported that calls are lower due to COVID.
- Chief Crowell stated that he is working through the new discovery requirements.
- The department has given a conditional offer of employment to Kaitlin Beebe.
- The department has 3 police officer vacancies to fill.
- The SPO's (Special Police Officers) are doing well.
- The department is now 80% vaccinated.
- Chief Crowell discussed changes related to the investigations of deaths that occur in police custody or related to the police department.
- The department CALEA Accreditation review is complete, and a report will be made available soon. The review went very well.
- There have been 2 robberies in 2 days and the department is investigating.

Member Champagne reported that there would be no easter egg hunt this year. Member Champagne thanked the department for speed patrols in the Village of Minoa.

Member Kinsella reported that the Village of Fayetteville is considering decreasing the speed limit on Village streets.
