

5. Dedication of Roads and Return of Highway Securities

Councilor Bollinger made a motion, seconded by Councilor Kriesel, to dedicate 2,200 feet of Phase 2 of Turning Leaf Dr. and to return 100% of highway securities being held in the amount of \$22,770.

3. Decoy Run along Enders Rd. survey data is being gathered.
4. Muirfield Dr. drainage project will need to be done in phases and talks have started on what work will be done in phase 1.

Engineer Miller gave an update on continuing work on the Climate Smart Program. Engineer Miller stated they have at least 70 items that qualify for credit in the Climate Smart Program in different categories, and the work continues.

10. Highway Superintendent

Superintendent Cushing stated that a resident located at 8280 Sugarland Dr. has requested a highway permit to work within the towns right away to tie into the towns sewer line at this address.

Councilor Bollinger made a motion, seconded by Councilor Deer, to authorize the Supervisor to sign the Highway Permit to allow Konrad Builders to tie into the towns sewer line for 8280 Sugarland Dr.
