- A conditional offer of employment has been made to a new employee.
- The department is working to fill four vacancies for police officers.
- February in service training program will begin on the 3rd.

12. Town Manager

Town Manager Oot stated the final payment on the town's window ban has been made.

13. Town Board

Councilor Waters stated that January 31st the Town will host Sunday Listening Session "Our History" with Town Historian Barbara Rivette at 3:00 PM.

Councilor Deer stated the Communication Committee will have their first meeting Friday February 29th.

Councilor Denton gave updates:

- Public Safety Advisory Committee has met and the most recent meeting is available on the Towns Facebook page.
- Councilor Denton stated the police reform county forums are on the County Website at policereform.ongov.net.
- The zoning update for small animals is being reviewed and there should be a draft available at the next board meeting.

Councilor Kriesel

- The State has released grant money for the Clean Energy Community Program which the town will begin applying for.
- The town is already a Climate Smart Community and is working toward the next level in the program.

Councilor Kriesel requested a resolution be adopted by the board for the Climate Smart Community Program. One action requires that a recycling bin be placed next to every trash bin in our government buildings. The resolution will be submitted as evidence of the towns participation and the town is currently participating already in this action.

Councilor Kriesel made a motion, seconded by Councilor Denton, to pass an oral resolution requiring the placement of recycling bins wherever there is a trash bin in town government buildings.
